AWS Freeman-Fritts Appointment Procedures

Our clinic is open in our reception area for appointments to keep you and your pets safe from waiting outside. When entering our facility with your pet, a face mask is recommended. We are pleased to return to normal operations and are looking forward to serving you. If you prefer curbside service, please let our receptionist know when you check-in. We will continue to help ensure the safety of both you and your loved ones.

The shelter is beginning to open but current guidelines are still in place for our adoption process.

How to adopt in 5 easy steps:

1. Click on adopt button to find the dog or cat you are interested in adopting.
2. Request an application by emailing us from that animal's photo and biography.
3. Fill out the application (we will contact you when it has been reviewed).
4. Meet your choice outside at the shelter to see if you are a good fit.
5. Fill out the final paperwork and pay the adoption fee.

The Freeman-Fritts Vet Clinic has a limited dog and cat spay/neuter fund available. This fund allows us to offer FREE spay/neuter surgeries (including Rabies Vaccination) for your cat or dog. Call for an appointment 830-257-4144. Some restrictions may apply.

Surgery Reminders!

- If you are unable to keep your surgery appointment, please call to cancel as soon as possible. This will give us an opportunity to schedule another client.
- NO FOOD after your pet's evening meal, preferably no later than 6 p.m. Water is acceptable.
- Please have your pet on a leash or in a carrier!
