Ways to Keep A Cat Warm in the Winter

These do it yourself cubbies are being made for feral cats. You can make one for your own cat, or that stray you've been feeding. There are several ways to make them. if you have an outdoor cat or a stray colony of cats that must stay outside, build them a [shelter](#) out of scrap wood. [The United States Humane Society](#) says to make sure you do not use “blankets, towels, or folded newspaper; they absorb body heat and chill cats who are lying on them.” Straw stuffed in pillowcases is best. If you can afford a commercial model, there are quite a few available on the market.

According to [Alley Cat Allies](#), feed cats more food in the winter for “an extra caloric boost” and feed wet food because “It’s easier to digest, so cats save more energy for keeping warm.”


